ONE UNIV, ONE BOOK

Guidelines for the discussion of *Man's Search for Meaning*

1. In many college campuses right now, educators are promoting the idea, "One Campus, One Book." Given all the different courses, ideas, and interests of students, it is often difficult to enable a common discussion among all students. So, we suggest encouraging all students to read the same book as a basis for a common discussion. That is, "One UNIV, One Book."

2. In this activity, participants will read Viktor Frankl's *Man's Search for Meaning*. The leader of the seminar will give a short introduction to the book, inciting the audience to pose their own questions in developing a common discussion about the meaning of life, maintaining human dignity in difficult circumstances, the importance of humor, and maintaining hope and courage in the face of suffering.

A student interested in the seminar should acquire a copy of Frankl's work.

3. The activity will take place during the UNIV Forum in Rome, on Tuesday, April 19th, from 12.00 to 13.00.
